Submissions

Submission of a paper to *Commentarii Mathematici Univ. St. Pauli* acknowledges that the paper is original and is not submitted elsewhere. As a rule, manuscripts should be submitted in electronic form as a pdf-file attached to an electronic message sent to:

editor@rikkyo.ac.jp

Publication should be written in English, French or German. Please provide the following when submitting a paper:

- A pdf of the manuscript.
- 2020 Mathematics Subject Classifications.
- An abstract of no more than 300 words. Papers written in French or German should include a version of the abstract in English.
- At acceptance, a copy of the manuscript in LaTeX2e.
- Authors can indicate the editor scientifically closest to the topic of the submission.

Authors of papers which have been accepted for publication will be asked to sign a copyright agreement. Authors of accepted papers can post pdf files of their final draft (post-refereeing) versions of their papers on personal webpages, electronic preprint servers, and institutional non-commercial repositories. Authors can link to the publisher's version of their articles as soon as they are available.

Page proofs will be made available to authors in pdf format. Substantial changes in content are not allowed without the approval of the Editor.
