凡 例

1. 本目録は、立教大学アメリカ研究所蔵書（洋書）のうち、アメリカ合衆国の文学、地理、伝記、資料、参考書等および同研究所蔵書目録Ⅰ（アメリカ合衆国の歴史、政治、経済、社会、哲学、宗教、教育、ジャーナリズム）の補遺を集録してある。
2. 各分類内の配列は原則として著者（編者）名のアルファベット順であるが、文学の中の“Works and Studies of Individual Authors”と BIOGRAPHY では、作家名、人物名（アンダーラインで示してある）のアルファベット順、かつ各作家、人物の項目内で著者（編者）名のアルファベット順である。
3. 個々の記述は、著者（編者）名、書名、発行所、発行年、頁数、シリーズ名の順である。
4. 巻末には著者（編者）名および対象となった作家、人物名（作家論、伝記の場合）の索引を付した。
5. 和書については引続いて刊行の予定である。
